Trailblazers meets on Mondays (4th grade) and Wednesdays (5th grade).

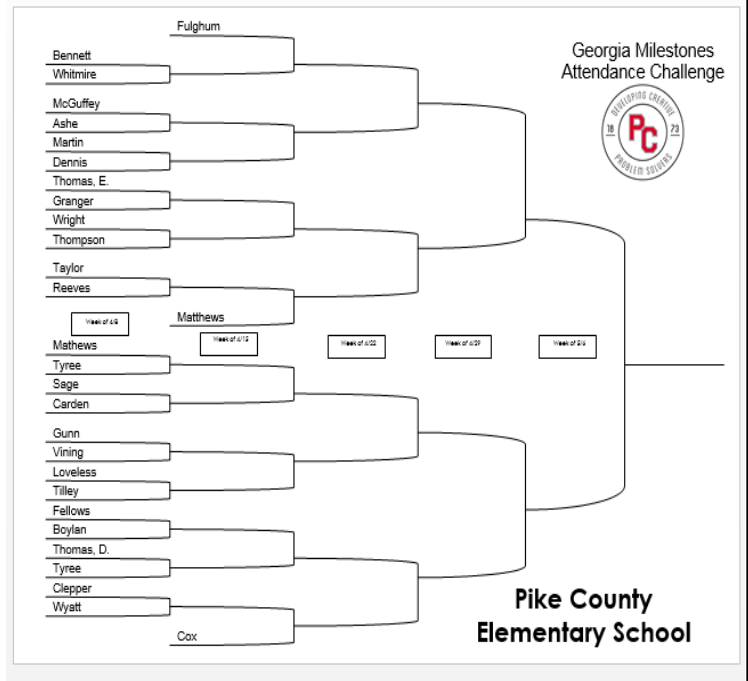
